Navamsa is the Main Purpose chart for Marriage to fine tune our Prediction. If Mercury or Moon is positioned in the Seventh House, the person will get married at a very young age between eighteen and Twenty three. If the Seventh House is occupied by Jupiter, the person will get married between Twenty four years and Twenty six years. Sun spotted in the Seventh House indicates the marriage shall be delayed and also faces a lot of obstacles. Mars in Seventh House is popularly known as Sevvai Dhosam, which causes serious delays in marriage. If Saturn sits in the Seventh House, then the person shall get married only after Thirty five years or even more.

Houses in Astrology that Affect Marriage:
